The student is part of the family, joining in social functions, church, sporting events, or whatever the family does!

**ARE THERE OTHER FINANCIAL OR ENTERTAINMENT RESPONSIBILITIES?** No. Students will have personal spending money.

**WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF HOSTING AND HOMESCHOOLING A SHORT TERM INTERNATIONAL STUDENT?** The stay is brief, but lasting relationships can develop between the host family and the visiting student. In your home, students come to know the best of Americans, having an opportunity to experience your care and your example of American character. The world comes right to your doorstep, providing a natural opportunity for your family members to experience cultural awareness and understanding and the privilege of representing our character and country right from home!
